<u>Purpose</u>

This course is designed to spark the imagination of children by exploring international myths and legends. Students will be encouraged to look at the world in new ways as they listen to, research and present myths and legends from often unknown cultures around the world.

Goals

Students complete the course with a better understanding of different world cultures and a curiosity to learn more about the living (and unliving) beings that inhabit it. Students must work independently to learn and retell myths. Students will need to debate and express themselves clearly while also using their own creativity to develop their own stories.
